The tuition fee includes: The October Enrichment week (Half-Term break), the February ski and snowboarding week (Half-Term break), laundry, and weekend activities.

Mandatory Extras include: Health and accident insurance, school books, ski & snowboard group lessons (Spring Term), and the season ski pass (Spring Term), uniform hire (term pupils).

Not included and will be invoiced: Sports equipment rental (ski and snowboard gear), private tutoring, music lessons, visa fees, special transfers, special recreational activities (i.e. horse riding, golf.), external examinations.

Uniform: The uniform must be purchased online at parents cost and delivered directly to MCS. Pupils staying for one term can hire the uniform, those staying for two or more term must purchase.

Student wallet: Each pupil can make use of a student wallet. Parents add money into this wallet at the start of term and pupils can withdraw throughout the term for personal expenses, such as purchases at the pupil lounge, and pocket money. A maximum of CHF 50 may be withdrawn per week. Any funds remaining at the end of the pupil's time at MCS will be refunded.

School trip: Only one school trip is at an additional cost: 5-day visit to the UK, May'22 (Malvern College UK / Universities / Excursions) CHF 1000.-
