

DIRECT ENTRY ADMISSION REQUIREMENT UPDATE

Fall 2022

The University of Manitoba is moving to a new four course model for direct entry admissions. The new model requires all programs to include a grade 12 (senior level) Mathematics and English course in the admission average calculation. In addition, the new model features varying minimum course averages by program.

The new program-specific admission requirements effective for the Fall 2022 intake are listed in the table below. It is important to review this document in conjunction with the <u>Applicant Information Bulletin</u> to ensure that you have understood all admission requirements and policies for the intake for which you apply.

Please note that the general entrance requirements for all programs (high school graduation including five full credits at the senior level) will remain unchanged.
