The College team has over 20 years' experience of providing education to international students. Our team of hard-working staff are passionate about providing a positive and caring environment for all students.

The campus offers a safe and secure location with high quality teaching and residential facilities. Student accommodation are well appointed shared rooms all with en-suite bathrooms. The spacious rooms at the campus are homely, calm and welcoming with windows overlooking the gardens.

All students are supervised throughout their stay by an experienced team of managers, teachers, pastoral staff and residential supervisors. During the day students are supported by teaching and/or activity staff. During the evenings supervision will be carried out by the residential management staff.

The College caters for all dietary needs. Meals are in the dining room or in the gardens. On day trips, a packed lunch is provided.

Free wi-fi is available in all bedrooms, classrooms and into the gardens.

The Cambridge Melchior College campus is set in beautiful landscaped gardens in Willingham, a village based 15 minutes drive away from the centre of Cambridge. Willingham provides a wide range of facilities including a library, post office, shops, cafes, tea rooms, doctor's surgery and sports facilities.

There are fast and reliable transport links to Cambridge, London and beyond. Students wishing to visit London can take a train from Cambridge and be there in under an hour.

A levels are more formally known as the General Certificate of Education Advanced Level. A levels are:

- A school leaving certificate offered by examination boards in the UK
- Generally worked towards over two years
- Are usually taken after successful completion of a previous level of course, such as GCSEs
- Are usually taken by students over the age of 16

Students select three-four subjects that really interest them and facilitate progression. You will spend approximately 24 hours per week in class.

Entry requirements:

- Normally must be at least 16 years old on 1st September of the year entry
- 5 GCSE at C grade or above, one of which must be mathematics, or equivalent
- Applicants are required to demonstrate proficiency in the English language before they are admitted to CMC through possession of a recognised English language qualification at IELTS 5.0 (overall band score), or equivalent
- Complete the CMC application form
- Parental consent form (students under 18)
- Copies of latest/most recent academic report
- Copies of all relevant certificates, including IELTS or Cambridge English Certificates
- Copy of passport
- Good educational references - including attendance (relating to previous 2 years)
- Meet UKVI financial requirements
- Successful interview: Must be able to demonstrate vocational aptitude at an appropriate skill level

Must evidence high levels of motivation and commitment, as these are vital for successful completion of these courses.

While we encourage you to choose subjects you enjoy, we have grouped subjects in pathways and recommend the following choices in preparation for specific degree areas:

Humanities for Business, Humanities and Law students: four subjects chosen from Maths, Economics, Accounting, Business Studies, English Literature, History, Government & Politics, Philosophy, Sociology and Psychology.

Sciences for Scientists and Engineers: four subjects chosen from Mathematics, Further Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

Arts for fine and applied artists: four subjects chosen from Art, History of Art, English Literature, History, Politics, Philosophy, Sociology and Psychology.
