An iGCSE Maths and Language Certificate is taken at the end of the course (UKVI exam if required for visa purposes)

## Entry requirements

- Age 16+ (under 16s accepted if approved accommodation or private fostering services are chosen)
- CEFR B1 level or IELTS 4.0 or above, or equivalent – Pearson PTE (29-35), TOEFL iBT (32-34) or Cambridge English Scale (147)
