The program is considered comprehensive for professionals from all specialties who would like to develop their knowledge and skills in sustainable humanitarian action, innovation in the humanitarian field, and humanitarianism strategies and planning. A university degree is required for admission to the program.

- Acquire a sustainable mindset to deliver sustainable projects.
- Attain critical humanitarian management skills and knowledge.

LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

Using a blended learning environment, students enrolled in the program will experience both physical and virtual classroom attendance, practical training, and visit many conferences and study sessions to achieve the highest quality of learning and thus empowering, promoting, and training future humanitarian entrepreneurs with sustainable mindsets while enhancing their skills. The Program is set to start during the month of October and continue for one academic year. Selected Students will enroll in a one-year program undertaking a total of 60 credit hours, get involved in a practical internship with one of DIHAD's prestigious partners, and ultimately submit a thesis paper to graduate with a Master's Degree in Sustainable Humanitarian Action.
